

Accelerated Reader (AR) Requirements and Awards

How does AR work?



- Students will take a test on the computer to determine their reading level and this will ensure that they will be reading and quizzing on books that are not too hard and not too easy.

- After reading a book, the student will fill out their AR log book and then take that to the computer to quiz. Quizzing can only be done at school.
- Small books are worth half a point, and longer chapter books will be worth more points.
- Every child has an individualized goal based on their reading level. We expect every child to reach their AR goal **every six weeks!**



What AR Awards can my child earn?



- If a student is on track to make their goal at the end of the month, they will receive a **Pizza Hut Book it!** Pizza coupon.

- **Goals met for the 6 weeks:** Students must meet their goal (points and average of 90)
- **All Goals Met:** Students met their goal (points and average) for 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th Six Weeks: A medal and field trip will be awarded at the end of the school year



- **Century Club:** For 1st and 2nd Graders only: Students must have a 90% average and earn 100 AR points for the year. A trophy and field trip will be awarded at the end of the year.

- **Millionaire Reader:** Students have read One Million Words with a 90% average. A trophy and field trip will be awarded at the end of the school year.
